
The training assessment and quality assurance qualifications (TAQA) can be undertaken with Cooke Training and Development.

They have been developed for those working in accredited learning, non accredited learning, the NQF and the QCF.

The Level 3 Award in Understanding the Principles and Practices of Assessment (QCF) is intended for those who wish to gain an understanding of the principles and practices of assessment without any requirement to practice as assessors.

This qualification is ideal, therefore, for those individuals new to assessment and hoping to become



an assessor. In addition, it is beneficial for those whose role requires them to know about essential principles and practices of assessment, but never practice, for example, programme administrators and managers.

The Level 3 Award in Assessing Competence in the Work Environment is intended for assessors who assess occupational competence in an individual's work environment. It includes the following assessment methods (although not all of these require performance evidence):

- observation of performance in the work environment
- examining products of work
- questioning the learner
- professional discussion with the learner
- use of witness testimony
- learner statements and/or reflective accounts
- recognition of prior learning
